Occupancy Ordinance

301.4 A. No new building shall be occupied until the Certificate of Occupancy shall have been issued by the Building Inspector. The Certificate of Occupancy issued for a residential structure shall remain in force until such time as the structure has been demolished, but does not apply to altered sections or additions. The altered section or addition shall not be occupied or used until a separate certificate has been issued by the Building Inspector certifying that the work has been completed in accordance with the provisions of the approved permit. For other than residential structures, a Certificate of Occupancy shall be required for the structure certifying that the work has been completed in accordance with the provisions of the building permit and site plan, and a separate Certificate of Occupancy shall be associated with the occupant of the structure. A new Certificate of Occupancy shall be required for each new occupant. In the case of multi-businesses in one structure, a separate Certificate of Occupancy is required for each business.
